These are limited production wines, but the star is the 2012 Pinot Noir Estate, a blend of four separate Pinot Noir clones (667, Pommard, 115 and 777). Russell Bevan, the consulting winemaker, has achieved a lovely, soft, velvety textured wine with Burgundian forest floor, black and red currant fruit, and some floral notes in a lush, juicy, sexy style of Pinot Noir. Drink it over the next 5-6 years.
